Greetings and Happy Summer from Michigan, the Great Lake State! The front island trees have been trimmed and they are looking great with our beautiful shells.

The Florida Department of Transportation will be installing left turn signals at the intersection of Oriole and 776 in the near future and this will be a great safety enhancement for our park entrance and will help traffic flow much better.

Please keep your property mowed and trimmed during the rainy season. If you find that there is property that needs the Board's attention, please feel free to reach out to us via email or phone; we will be glad to look into situations that are not in line with our deed restrictions.

Be a considerate pet owner – pick up after your pet, and if you walk on a long leash, please do not let your pet wander up into a yard and do their business. **Dogs must be kept on a leash if off your property – this is not only in our deed restrictions but is a Charlotte County law.** If there are issues with this, please contact Animal Control.

Friendly reminder – walk against traffic and ride with traffic. And please remember that the speed limit throughout the park is 25 mph.

There is to be no parking of any non-auto/truck vehicles (boats, trailers, motor homes, etc.), that are not under a carport. **No RV shall be parked or stored on the owner's property for more than five (5) consecutive calendar days within any thirty (30) day period (please see Deed Restriction #13 for further information).**

We are now officially into Hurricane season which runs from June - November, so be aware of the weather, listen to the warnings...most of all stay safe.

You may have heard that recently Florida has reported more than 5,000 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the state. Thursday's rise in reported cases was lower than Wednesday's record-setting mark, but it's only the second time the state has crossed the 5,000-case mark in a day. In total, the state has reported more than 114,000 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and at least 3,327 coronavirus-related deaths. **Charlotte County Statistics as of June 25th, Total Cases: 626 (Up by 9 in past 24 hours)** Residents: 623; Residents Not in Florida: 0; Non-Residents: 3.
